- Be responsible for keeping shelves and bins restocked while ensuring proper product rotation and quality; handle product damages and credits according to AFC policy

- Be invested in the cooperative mission
- Help promote and market the Coop

- Must be able to obtain Washington State Food Handlers Permit
- Able to lift 35 pounds and occasionally lift up to 50 pounds
